The **European University of Rome** hosts a training and networking series of Residential **Seminars** on **Competition law, policy and enforcement** in digital markets (**DiCo Project – Digital Markets and Competition Policy**) devoted and reserved to **EU national judges**.

DiCo is a two-year project, funded by the European Commission, divided into <u>two distinct course</u> <u>editions</u>, the first one being held in Rome from 25 October 2023 to 27 October 2023.

DiCo is specifically addressed to: i) National Judges dealing with competition law cases at national level; ii) National judges interested in competitive issues in digital markets; iii) Prosecutors, Apprentice National Judges, and the staff of the Judges' Offices.

Accepted applicants commit to participate in person to the residential and networking activity. Participation in DiCo is free of charge. Travel and accommodation costs in Rome for the selected participants will be covered by the Project within the caps set at EU level.
