## **Joint Educational Program with London School of Economics**

### **Call for Applications**

#### **Department of Economics and Psychology**

#### **Students enrolled in academic year 2017-2018**

##### **1. General rules**

- a. UER and London School of Economics have a Joint Educational Partnership, that permits UER students to attend a LSE Summer School of Business and Management.
- b. Will be considered to participate students enrolled in:
  - 2nd and 3rd year of Bachelor Degree in Economics and Business Administration;
  - 2nd and 3rd year of Bachelor Degree in Psychological Sciences and Techniques (curricula of Psychology of Work and Organizations);
  - 1st and 2nd year of Master Degree in Economics and Innovation Management;
  - 1st and 2nd year of Master of Science in Psychology (curricula of Psychology of Work and Organizations).
- c. The period of mobility will be July 9-27 (session 2) & July 30 – August 17 (session 3) 2018.
- d. The students during their stay at LSE will be continuing to be registered and to pay their regular fees at UER.
- e. Students will cover by themselves all expenses related to their participation in the program, notably Summer School fees and taxes, transport, accommodation and food, administrative expenses, expenses associated with securing a visa, medical/health/accident insurance, books and personal expenses.
- f. UER will grant to the students selected a scholarship of € 800. The total number of scholarship for LSE Summer School 2018 are 4.
- g. Selected students, in order to attend LSE Summer School Program, will have to be in compliance with both universities' rules and conditions, as for credits envisaged, attendance, deadlines, etc...
- h. The successful participation in the LSE Summer School 2018, duly attested by LSE certificate, will grant the attending students the transfer of 8 CFU as “optional course”.

##### **2. Eligibility and selection requirements**

- a. The selection of students is made through the non-disputable evaluation of an Academic Commission nominated by the Dean.

- b. The Program is open to students above-mentioned in art. 1, let. B). They will be able to participate and are therefore considered eligible only if, within the official Fall examination session a.y. 2017-2018 (February 2018):
- They will have passed and registered at least a total of
    - 70 ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in 2017-2018 in the second year of Bachelor Degree;
    - 135 ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in 2017-2018 in the third year of Bachelor Degree;
    - 16 ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in 2017-2018 in the first year of Master Degree;
    - 70 ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in 2017-2018 in the second year of Master Degree;
  - They hold a weighted average grade equal or above 28/30;
  - They hold an international certificate accepted by London School of Economics (internet based TOEFL – minimum score 107, IELTS – minimum score 7.0 or their equivalent).
- c. The selection follows a 2 step process:

**Step 1:** The eligible candidates will be ranked after the analysis of their academic performance (credits and average grade, each weighting 55% and 45% of the academic score), the English language proficiency and the analysis of the motivation letter, letters of reference and curriculum vitae.

The Academic Commission will rank eligible students and create the short list for the next step. In order to create the ranking, the Commission may call a short list of candidates for a motivational interview, held in English (**February 23<sup>th</sup>, TBC**).

In case a candidate is not considered suitable by the Commission, he/she will not be selected regardless of the academic performance, the positioning in the applicants' ranking and the number of available slots.

**Step 2:** LSE will receive from UER the short list of candidates already ranked by the LSE Commission with their dossier. LSE will consider the admission of all students registered at and nominated by UER subject to acceptance of their qualifications and availability of places in their chosen subjects.

### **3. E. Application Procedure**

- a. The application deadline for participating to the selection, by handling the application form to the International Relations Office (Room BT02), will be **February 22<sup>th</sup> at 13.00**.
- b. Students will be able to participate only if their administrative position is regular and have no pending administrative issues with UNIVERSITÀ EUROPEA DI ROMA.

### **4. F. Publication of results and orientation for departure**

- a. The selection results will be published online on **February 26<sup>th</sup>** Selected students will be required to confirm their acceptance through LSE Summer School online application with any supporting documentation and transcript(s) within **February 28<sup>th</sup>**.
- b. Students will be responsible for all procedures regarding application, learning agreement and the following registration procedures to London School of Economics.
