To participate you will need (the following documents are only available in Italian):

- to certify the indispensable minimum educational requirements by obtaining a **sworn translation of your title**. Foreign documents must be translated into Italian and legalised by the competent Italian diplomatic authority in your country. For further information on this procedure visit the following [link](#).
- to certify a good command of the Italian language by obtaining an **Italian language certification** corresponding to a B1 -B2 level within the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). If necessary, it can be issued by the UER under examination. The UER offers the opportunity to take the Italian test on **11th September 2018 at 11.00 a.m.** at the Università Europea di Roma.
- the [application form](#), filled in online, printed and signed (read the [guide for filling in the online application](#)). Remember your username and password, you will need them upon registration.
- the [admission questionnaire](#), printed and filled in with a pen. It is a very important document, to be completed with the utmost attention in each of its parts.
- [self-certification](#) of the grade average point (or, if already graduated, the high school diploma).

- photocopy of identity document
- tax code (*Codice fiscale*)
- three recent coloured passport photos.
- Residence permit (*Permesso di Soggiorno*) (for non – EU citizens)

For parents of students who take the admission test, an information meeting will be held with the participation of the Rector and the General Secretary, where information about the University and admission and registration procedures for the degree courses will be provided.
