RELEVANT RESEARCH EXPERIENCES

A first line of my research focuses on the development of intent-based moral judgment. I conducted experiments on the moral judgment of preschoolers, school-age children, young and old adults. In particular, I investigated the developmental changes occurring in the attribution of *moral goodness* and its underlying cognitive processes. I am also interested in examining the contribution of theory of mind and executive functioning abilities to developmental changes in moral judgment. I am pursuing this line of research in Rovereto, Department of Psychology and Cognitive Science, University of Trento, under the supervision of Prof. Luca Surian.

A second line of my research focuses on infants' understanding of social power relations. I am interested in revealing our early mechanisms of representation of social relationships, with a particular focus on the *leader-followers relation*. By using the violation of expectation paradigm, I investigated whether infants distinguish between two types of dominance relations: legitimate rule by a leader and coercion by a bully. I initially pursued this line of research under the supervision of Prof. Renée Baillargeon, at the University of Illinois. There, I learned how to design and run an experiment to assess infants' expectations by measuring infants' looking times. I am now following up this research project on early social expectations at the University of Trento.
