

## Study Abroad Cancellation Policy

Students enrolled in the Study Abroad Program can withdraw at any moment.

- If you withdraw after receiving the Letter of Acceptance, the **Application Fee** of €300 is nonrefundable but may be applied to another program within one year of the application date if you decide to postpone studying abroad.
- If you withdraw after the beginning of the Orientation Week, the **Service Fee** of €300 is nonrefundable.
- **Tuition fee** is refundable only by request according to the following rules:

**Within 40 days** from the beginning of the Orientation Week, UER International Relation Office will consider a refund request if you have a compelling reason (medical, illness/death in immediate family, academic, military, unanticipated financial situation or other) and supporting documentation. A decision will be communicated within 30 days and if the request is accepted, the amount of the refund will be at the sole discretion of UER. Student will receive a refund up to 90 days after the UER decision has been communicated.

**After 40 days** from the beginning of the Orientation Week, UER International Relation Office will not refund any amount.

- The Study Abroad Program fee is based on the number of ECTS chosen through the Single Course Application Form. Whenever you decide to reduce the number of ECTS after receiving the Letter of Acceptance, you will not be refunded the fee **difference** between the number of ECTS contained in the Single Course Application Form and the Learning Agreement/Credit Recognition Form.

### Study Abroad Cancellation Policy Summary

- Application Fee of €300 is nonrefundable after receiving the Letter of Acceptance.
- Service Fee of €300 is nonrefundable after the beginning of the Orientation Week.
- Tuition fees within 40 days from the beginning of the Orientation Week are partly refundable at the sole discretion of UER.
- Tuition fees after 40 days from the beginning of the Orientation Week are nonrefundable.
- In case of reducing the number of ECTS from the Single Course Application Form, the fee difference is nonrefundable.
