

Summer School Program with London School of Economics (LSE)

Call for Applications

For students of the Faculties of Economics and Psychology

1. General rules

- a. UER and London School of Economics have a Joint Educational Partnership, that permits UER students to attend the LSE Summer School of Business and Management.
- b. Students will be considered for participation if they are currently enrolled in the:
 - 2nd and 3rd year of the Bachelor's degree in Economics and Business Management;
 - 2nd and 3rd year of the Bachelor's degree in Psychological Sciences and Techniques (Psychology of Work and Organizations' curriculum);
 - 1st and 2nd year of the Master's degree in Economics and Innovation Management;
 - 1st and 2nd year of the Master's degree in Psychology (Psychology of Work and Organizations' curriculum).

c. The period of mobility will be 31 Jul- 18 Aug 2023.

- d. The students will continue to be registered and pay their regular fees at UER during their stay at LSE.
- e. Selected students will self-cover expenditure relating to their participation in the program, notably Summer School's fees, transport, accommodation, food, administrative and personal expenses.
- f. Selected students will be granted a scholarship of €500. The total number of scholarships available for the LSE 2023 Summer School Program is 3.

- g. Selected students will have to follow both universities' rules and conditions, as for attendance, deadlines, etc.
- h. The successful participation in the program, duly attested by the LSE certificate, will grant students 6 CFU recognized at UER as an elective course.

2. Eligibility and selection requirements

- a. The students' selection is made by an Academic Commission nominated by the Dean.
- b. Above-mentioned students will be considered eligible only if, within the a.y. 2022/2023 Fall examination session:
 - they will have passed and registered at least a total of:
 - **70** ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in the second year of the Bachelor's degree;
 - \circ 135 ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in the third year of the Bachelor's degree;
 - 16 ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in the first year of the Master's degree;
 - \circ 70 ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in the second year of the Master's degree;
 - They have a weighted **average** grade of/above **26/30**;
 - They have an international **language certification** accepted by the London School of Economics (see <u>https://www.lse.ac.uk/study-at-lse/summer-schools/summer-school/how-to-apply</u>).
- c. The selection follows a **two-step process**:

Step 1: Eligible candidates will be shortlisted considering their academic performance (credits and weighted average grade, counting 55% and 45% of the academic score, respectively), their proficiency in English, motivation letter, curriculum vitae or any recommendation letter.

Step 2: LSE will receive from UER the list of candidates already evaluated by the its Commission with their dossier. LSE has the right to determine the final ranking after the analysis of the documentation previously transmitted.

3. Application Procedure

- a. The application deadline for participating in the selection process is **June 20th 2023.**
- b. Students will be able to participate only if they have no pending administrative issues with Università Europea di Roma.

4. Publication of results and orientation for departure

- a. The selection results will be published on the UER website on June 21st.
- b. Selected students will be required to confirm their acceptance through the LSE Summer School online application within **June 26th**.
- c. Students will be responsible for all procedures regarding application and registration to the London School of Economics.
